An NIH-funded doctoral or post-doctoral position is available in the Lim lab of Sensory Science at Oregon State University. The candidate will work with a diverse group of doctoral and post-doctoral trainees as well as PIs investigating sensory and metabolic mechanisms underlying oral carbohydrate sensing in humans. The research group implements a multidisciplinary approach to 1) identify the structural requirements of oligosaccharides that elicit taste, and 2) investigate the nature and significance of the glucose-specific signaling pathway. Approaches will include chemical, psychophysical, and physiological studies. Requirements include a M.S. or Ph.D. degree in any of the following fields of study: Chemistry, Food Science, Neuroscience, Nutrition, and Psychology.
