

Harvard Postdoctoral Research Fellow in Intracranial Olfactory Decoding (July 2022)

The Brain Modulation Laboratory within the Department of Neurosurgery at Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard Medical School seeks to recruit a highly motivated and outstanding candidate to fill a postdoctoral associate position, under supervision of PI Mark Richardson, MD, PhD.

The successful candidate will work in a highly interdisciplinary team to study olfactory evoked responses in the brain of awake patients, and to advance the goal of generating and restoring olfactory perceptions in humans by direct stimulation of olfactory centers in the brain. Co-investigators include PI Eric Holbrook, MD, Richard Costanzo, PhD, and Daniel Coelho, MD.

Experience in electrophysiology, olfactory and/or sensory perception research, and a solid background in computational neuroscience are required.
