

Slippery Rock University: Tenure-track Assistant Professor of Biology

Slippery Rock University invites applications for a tenure track Assistant Professor in the Department of Biology beginning August 2023. Primary teaching responsibilities will include Anatomy and Physiology I & II. Additional courses may include lower-level biology courses for both majors and non-majors, as well as courses in the faculty member's area of specialization. The successful candidate must exhibit a commitment to excellence in teaching in a Liberal Arts setting, establishment of a productive research program in the candidate's area of expertise that will involve undergraduates, and contribution to department, college, and university committees.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Broadly trained animal physiologist (PhD must be completed by July 1, 2023)
- Evidence of professional competence and ability to work productively with students and colleagues
- Commitment to the education of diverse populations
- Successful performance in an on-campus interview, including teaching and research presentations

Preferred Qualifications:

- At least 1 year of undergraduate teaching experience
- Evidence of teaching effectiveness
- Experience teaching Anatomy & Physiology

Applicants must apply electronically. Required documents include a curriculum vitae, cover letter, graduate and undergraduate transcripts, and statements of the applicants teaching and research philosophies.
