

The laboratory of Dan Wesson is seeking applications for a postdoctoral scholar position. Competitive candidates would have a strong interest in neurobiology, a commitment to excellent science, a passion for innovating and solving problems, outstanding organizational skills, and a high-level of intrinsic motivation.

Potential NIH/NIDCD-supported projects in the lab include:

- 1) Defining the brain systems responsible for generating odor valence and subsequent odor-motivated behaviors.
- 2) Determining why, and how, the olfactory system is vulnerable to dementia, including Alzheimer's disease and Parkinson's disease.

Successful candidates will join a well-equipped and vibrant lab with four other post-docs each working on independent projects, a PhD student, several undergraduate students, and two technicians.
